Party girl, who very popular at school, Maggie is obsessed with her phone. She is a little naive.

JEB (s)

Although he is the School Captain, Jeb doesn't have much concern for anyone but himself. This includes his girlfriend Maggie.

The Past

MELLY (1927) (s)

She lives in the excitement of a new world with great music and vegemite.

NANCY (1936)

She finds herself alone and having to make a decision with little support from the society of the 1930's.

SANDRA (1943) (s)

Lived in the war years, and has to say goodbye to her brother as he is sent overseas.

KATIE (1955) (s)

She is in love with Rod, but they are from very different backgrounds.

PATTIE (1964) (s)

An almost sugar sweet child of the sixties.

RACHAEL (1976) (s)

Ready to take on the world and the music industry

ANDY (1936)

He is a boy who is not ready to have the responsibilities of a family.

KANE (1943)

Kane is the oldest son and breadwinner in the family, who has been called up to fight.

ROD (1955) (s)

He is a former lost street kid, new in town that has fallen in love with Katie.

DANIEL (1964) (s)

With Patti, they form the perfect couple. He is always bright and enthusiastic.

HENRY (1976)
